



EAGLE P3 COMMUTER RAIL MANAGING COMPLEX REGULATORY CONSTRAINTS

Eagle P3 is a portion of the Regional Transportation District (RTD) FasTracks plan expanding public transit across the Denver metro area. Denver Transit Partners (DTP) needed a consultant to ensure environmental goals and stakeholders' concerns were met. Kleinfelder helped DTP's design and construction team navigate the complicated regulatory framework of federal, state, and private funding.

SPECIFIC PROJECT CHALLENGES

Coordinating with project staff throughout all construction phases required a proactive approach to ensure environmental compliance and provide documentation to prove it. Environmental concerns included impacts to protected species and habitats, and management of known and unknown hazardous materials in the project corridor. Kleinfelder trained project staff, observed all elements of construction, and resolved compliance issues, keeping the project delivery on time.


MINIMIZING SCHEDULE DELAYS

EXPEDITING ENVIRONMENTAL DATA GATHERING

Kleinfelder's custom electronic data collection system provided real-time information to project staff and regulatory agencies. The system reduced project risks by disseminating information from the field to appropriate contacts immediately at the end of each work day. Remote data access allowed local regulatory authorities to evaluate site conditions from afar—connecting them to the largest project in the Denver Metropolitan Area.
